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




A FOREWORD FROM OUR DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION

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

INITIAL CONSULTATION & PHONE CALL

Following your enquiry, you will receive a phone call from our Director of Education to discuss your child's specific learning needs and schedule your in-home consultation.

IN-HOME CONSULT & RESULTS REVIEW

Our Director of Education will spend 30-45 minutes with your child and 15-30 minutes discussing the results with you. The student's academic strengths and growth areas as well as their preferred learning styles will be identified.

BOOKINGS CONFIRMATION

At the conclusion of your consultation, you will have the opportunity to confirm your booking. An educator will be assigned to your child based on their social and emotional learning needs. Your educator will contact you to schedule your child's learning sessions at a mutually agreeable time.

INDIVIDUALISED

Once your booking has been confirmed, your teacher will work with your child to develop a learning program in conjunction with the current school curriculum and based on their individual needs.



REGULAR WEEKLY SESSIONS

Your child's educator will work with them on a regular basis to implement your child's learning program.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Our teaching and learning program works most effectively when sessions are successfully completed. If you cancel or reschedule a session, it is up to you to book a make-up session with your Full Spectrum Educator as soon as possible to ensure no components of the program are missed. No refunds are given on sessions that are not completed unless there are extenuating circumstances.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

At Full Spectrum Education, we provide our families with the Teachworks portal to fully manage your account with us. In Teachworks, you will be able to view upcoming lesson schedules, details of completed sessions, update payment details and even request changes of sessions directly with your educator.

Upon confirming your student's place with us and during the consultation you will be invited to complete your account registration and provide payment details. Our office will send you a welcome email, SMS and activation link to start your account. Before each session occurs, you will receive a SMS and email reminder to ensure you and the student are prepared so they can get the most out of the session. Each week after your educator has taught, they will mark their session as 'attended' in Teachworks, and can provide notes on the session to you via email.

All invoices are generated on a Monday and will be processed for payment on a Friday. If a session was cancelled it will be marked as 'cancelled' in Teachworks and you will receive an invoice advising of this, but no payment will be processed. If a session is logged as 'missed' this will be because we have been notified of a 'noshow' or a very late cancellation of service. This session will be charged. If you notice a discrepancy between our teacher's records being logged in Teachworks and your records please ensure you notify us at accounts@fsedu.com.au ASAP.





The FSE program has been built with you in mind, we understand that holidays may not be the time your child wants sessions. However, it is so important to upkeep sessions to maintain a routine and ensure academic success. Our robust team of educators are geared to help you, so make sure you are having these discussions with your teachers before the end of term to lock in your child's holiday learning. We operate on a 12-week term, 48-week a year learning model.



The school holidays are a time for rest and recovery, but they are also the perfect opportunity to review and consolidate the year's work while preparing for what the next term or year has in store. That's where we come in! Our team of FSE educators are ready to help your child throughout the school holidays to help them boost not just their marks next year, but also their confidence, time management and study skills. If your child is falling a bit behind in primary, attempting the transition to high school, an NDIS student, a student prepping for an ACER/scholarship test or a senior school student ready to kick goals in the New Year for their ATAR, let us help them!



What we provide here at Full Spectrum Education is different from traditional "tutoring"; we are an education company that provides individualised, one-on-one education that is the perfect addition to what a classroom teacher provides!

We get this figure of "80 minutes" spent with a child one-on-one per week by looking at the approximate time spend it in a class per session (60 minutes), which divided by the (QLD) regulated number of students per class (28) means that even if nothing is explicitly taught, a teacher will spend approximately 2 minutes with each child one-on-one. This number, multiplied by 4 (on average there are 3-4 classes per week in a high school) brings a teacher's average time with a child to just over 8 minutes if nothing is taught. Multiply that by a 10-week term, and it is 80 minutes.

We understand and appreciate the immense pressure a classroom teacher is put under to ensure all their students are meeting learning outcomes, which is why adding a Full Spectrum Educator to a child's learning system means they will have an additional 2 hours per week of learning, completely individualised to them.

BILLING INFORMATION



1. Weekly 2 hours via Teachworks Credit/Debit Card Payment - \$150 + GST per student.


2. 5% discount on fees if payment is made up front for the term or prorated (based on a 12-week term).

If the student is enrolled once the term has commenced the payment will be prorated (based on a 12-week term).

A \$50 non-refundable enrolment fee is payable upon confirmation of proceeding with the service. Payments are automatically processed on the invoice due date.

\$25 administration fee if payment is declined. Suspension of service will occur if more than 2 payments are declined until account is up to date.


If the student cannot make the lesson for what ever reason the lesson can be made up before the end of the term without penalty.







In the instance of individual cancellations due to sickness or any other reason, we advise our educators to schedule make up lessons with the client or add the time lost over several subsequent sessions. This ensures the consistency of learning and allow our teachers to obtain the intended results for the student. These lessons will be classified as either new lessons or have additional time added to existing lessons in Teachworks.



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THE FSE PROGRAM

Here at Full Spectrum Education we recognise the importance of catering for a diverse range of learners. To achieve this, we need to ensure that our program has incorporated into it the five dimensions of learning which are crucial to any student being successful.



Our lessons are structured using the pedagogical framework of Dr Anita Archer*. The Explicit Instruction model is used across the vast majority of Queensland schools day in and day out, from early primary right through to senior secondary.



It is important to recognise that every student's lesson will be individualised to cater to their respective learning needs. The Full Spectrum Education Model is the product of current research. Full Spectrum Educators use the Quality Teaching Framework from the NSW Department of Education, which is incorporated in all teaching and learning programs to ensure that quality education is being provided throughout the school and as a means of providing staff with a platform for critical reflection and analysis of current teaching practice, and used to guide planning of classroom and assessment practices (Department of Education, 2008).


